A	<p><b>LIFE SUPPORT</b></p> <p>Administer life support care to sick or injured persons in pre-hospital settings as authorized and directed by the physician. Assess nature and extent of the illness or injury to establish and prioritize medical procedures to be followed or need for additional assistance. Restore and stabilize heart rhythm on pulse-less, non-breathing patient using defibrillator, or as directed by the physician.</p>	1250
B	<p><b>CARDIAC MONITORING</b></p> <p>Monitor cardiac patient using electrocardiograph.</p>	500
C	<p><b>MISCELLANEOUS FIRST AID OPERATIONS</b></p> <p>Initiate intravenous fluids to administer medication or drugs or to replace fluids lacking in body. Perform endotracheal intubation to open airways and ventilate patient. Inflate pneumatic anti-shock garment on patient to improve blood circulation.</p>	500
D	<p><b>INJECTIONS</b></p> <p>Administer injections of medications and drugs following established protocols.</p>	250
E	<p><b>INITIAL TREATMENT</b></p> <p>Administer initial treatment at emergency scene and take and record patient's vital signs.</p>	500

<b>F</b>	<p><b>TRAPPED VICTIMS</b></p> <p>Assist in extricating trapped victims and transport sick and injured persons to treatment center.</p>	250
<b>G</b>	<p><b>PATIENT CONDITION</b></p> <p>Observe, record, and report to physician patient's condition and reaction to drugs, treatment, and significant incidents.</p>	500
<b>H</b>	<p><b>VEHICLE OPERATIONS</b></p> <p>Drive mobile intensive care unit to emergency scene.</p>	250
