<b>A</b>	<b>GENERAL REPAIR &amp; MAINTENANCE</b>	<b>500</b>
	-- Measure and hem curtains, garments, and canvas coverings to size, using tape measures.	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-- Spread out articles or materials and examine them for holes, tears, worn areas, and other defects.</li> <li>-- Stamp grommets into canvas, using mallets and punches or eyelet machines.</li> <li>-- Trim edges of cut or torn fabric, using scissors or knives, and stitch trimmed edges together.</li> </ul>	
<b>B</b>	<p><b>TECHNICAL REPAIR &amp; MAINTENANCE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-- Operate sewing machines to re-stitch defective seams, sew up holes, or replace components of fabric articles.</li> <li>-- Patch holes, sew tears and ripped seams, or darn defects in items, using needles and thread or sewing machines.</li> <li>-- Sew labels and emblems onto articles for identification.</li> <li>-- Repair holes by weaving thread over them, using needles.</li> </ul>	<b>1000</b>
<b>C</b>	<p><b>SURVIVAL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-- Check repaired and repacked survival equipment to ensure that it meets specifications.</li> </ul>	<b>500</b>
